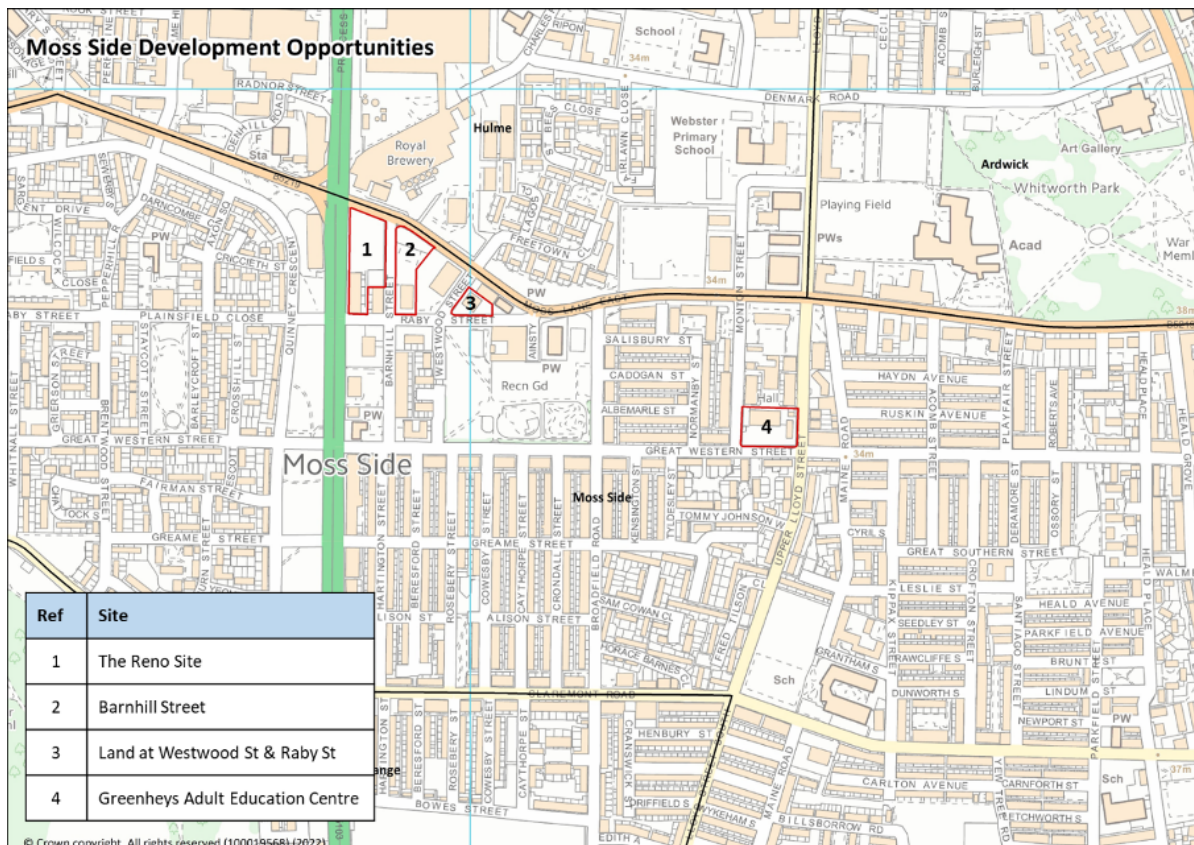
Engagement and Consultation Update – November 2023

Introduction

Manchester City Council and MSV Housing carried out a public consultation in the Moss Side area this year (from May through to end of August 2023), to consult local residents on the design proposals for the regeneration of four sites in Moss Side.

The extensive consultation included public meetings, online surveys, radio campaigns, attendance at the Manchester Caribbean Carnival, specific website and social media campaigns, and the establishment of a steering group made up of local stakeholders.

Proposed Sites in Moss Side

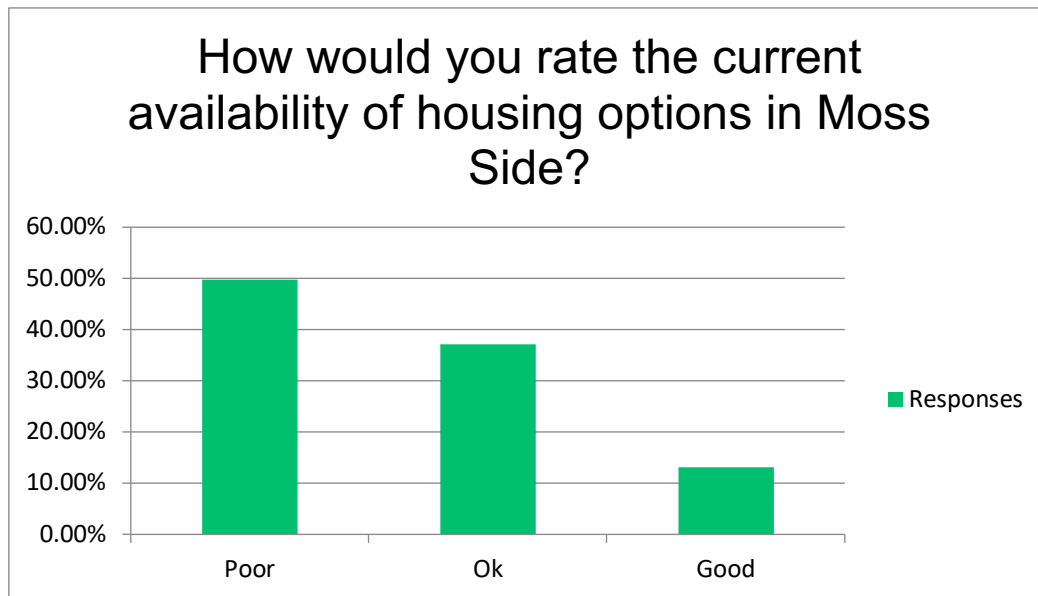


Consultation Summary

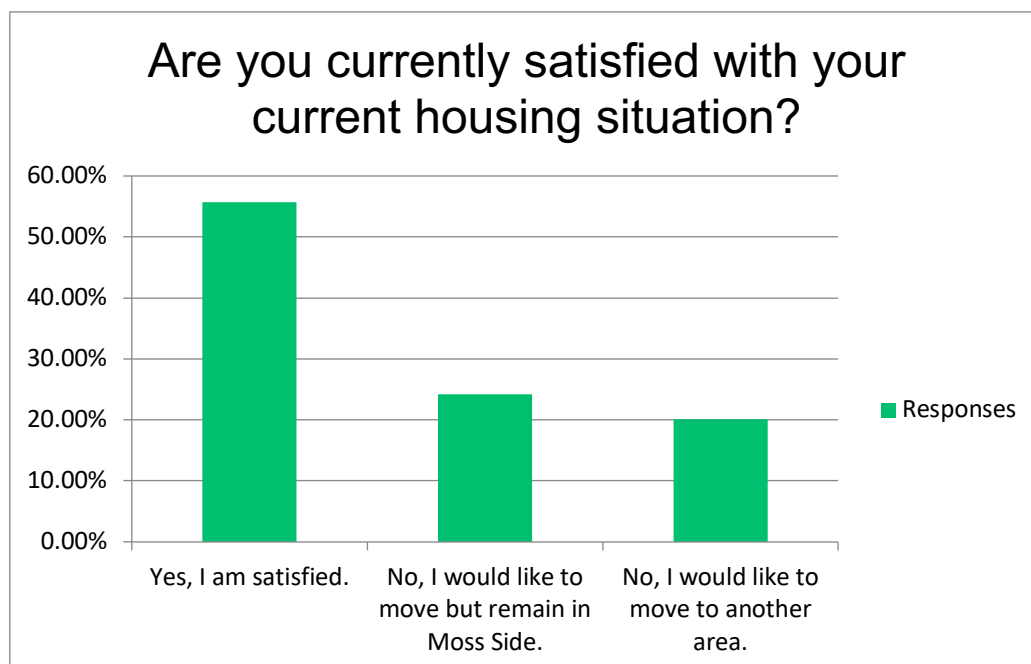
22 paper surveys were completed and received at the consultation event and a further 246 people have completed the online survey, resulting in a **total of 268 survey responses**.

A breakdown of the responses received is detailed below.

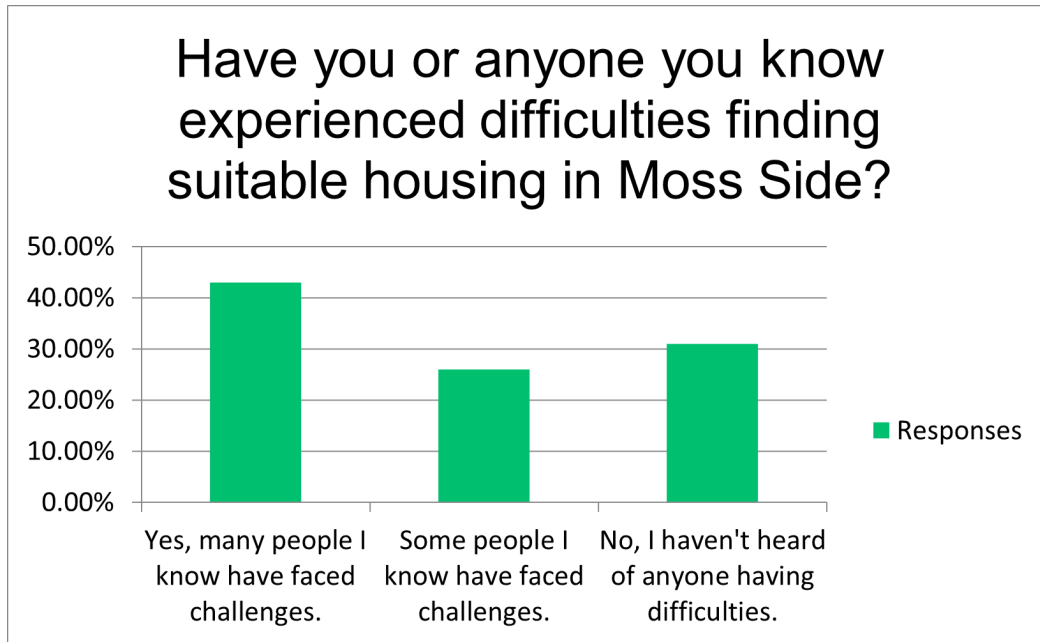

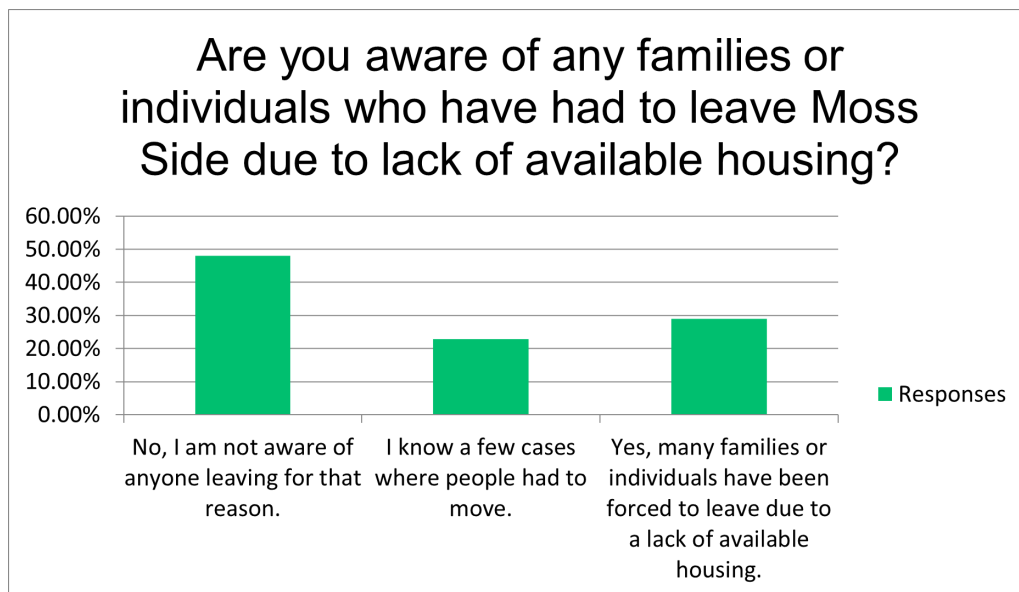


In the additional comments, the main comment also noted a lack of affordable homes to rent, followed by a need of provision of large family homes.

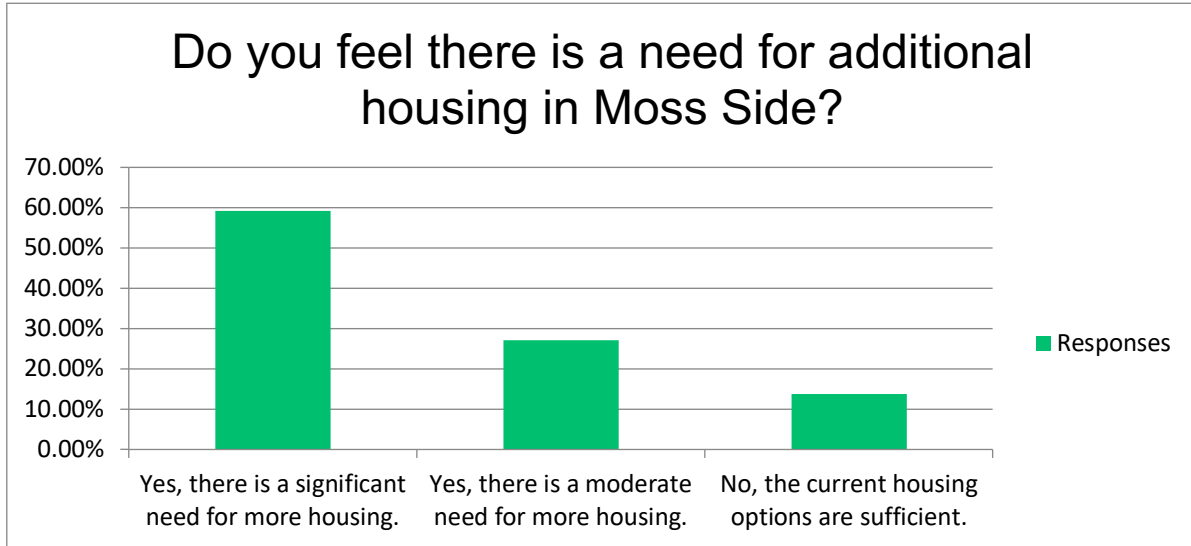
